- "It was Tuesday morning in MN as our plane touched down in Phnom Penh at 10:08 pm Tuesday. It had been seventeen months since we had left here to return home in early May of last year. It will soon be a year since Franz left us in November for his heavenly home. We are thankful we could care for him in our home during his final months."
- "We hope to be back in our Ban Lung home by the end of next week...we need to have our visas extended to cover our time here. Please pray that that the process will go smoothly and also that we can stay well and be able to help the progress of the Krung Bible translation work. **We hope to have the three epistles of John, and also Jude and Revelation, consultant checked during our time here.** Lord willing, our return to MN will be 23 May 2019."
